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1 Again students, welcome to the opening class of the 7th grade St. Aloysius Religious Education Program for 2019-2020.

2 Before we begin our class let us open with a prayer.

You obey your parents and come here

Mention conduct during the year and bad experiences last year; No sleeping & talking to neighbor.

I Hope to make this class an interesting and educational experience and to be a small part of your week that you may actually look forward to!

Ask if some find it difficult attending religious education.

Expectations: learn prayers (hand out prayers and folders), attend class, read the lesson and be prepared, be adult and courteous in in class (mention consequence) and you will be expected to participate.

I'm not here to deal with babies. I'm here to deal with young adults growing and learning to become mature adults.

Pass out paper to be signed and the expectations for homework.

3 Let's begin our lesson for todayI'd like to ask each of you for your impression of who God is and what he is like.

The reason I asked this is because most people your age feel that god is an old man with a beard sitting on some cloud just waiting to punish people for when they do wrong.

Old man with beard cracking the whip when we do wrong

Wanting to punish people and send them to hell

I would like to know how you feel about our God.

How would you describe god, from your point of view? Go around room.

Comment on their opinions

Would you like to hear how God described himself?

Ask if they know

4 This is how he described himself: as a mother hen gather her chicks.

Comment on this, how loving and caring this is.

Matthew 23:37 'Jerusalem! Jerusalem!

You kill the prophets. You throw stones

to kill the men who are sent to you! How often I have wanted to gather your people together, as a **mother hen** gathers her little ones under her wings. But you would not come!

Do you feel like you want to be a son or daughter to the almighty being, whom we call God to be a Father you?

I do, comment on how happy you are you have a God to run to.

I'd like to ask you a question: how old is everyone?

Look at events that happened 16 years ago.

6 Marlins winning the World Series

8 Where were you on New Year's Eve in 2003?

You didn't exist!

What was it like not existing?

Well, we all exist now and we have 5 senses to know that we exist.

Ask them about the 5 senses

Let's talk a little about the senses

Go around the room and ask each for one of their favorite sounds

What is your favorite sound?

3 racing horses

What is your favorite vision?

10 beautiful birds

What is your favorite feeling?

OK, what is the point of all this?

The Question is; What would you prefer, nonexistence or existence with all these benefits of our senses.

With existence we not only have our senses but we have all our experiences.

Show experiences

If we love all these experiences and the things we sense with our senses you must admit this is better than not existing, correct?

Who agrees and...... who disagrees?

It is natural for us to say we are thankful for this life, correct?

If so to whom should we give our thanks?

Why to God, because he **is** life.
