The four parts of the mass

1.the gathering rite

2.the liturgy of the word

3.the liturgy of the Eucharist

4. the dismissal

The Gathering Rite

1. entrance
2. act of penance
3. lord have mercy
4. glory to god, we offer him glory
5. collect, a short prayer

The liturgy of the word

- 1. first reading from the old testament*
- 2. responsorial psalm*
- 3. second reading from the new testament
writers like St. Paul*
- 4. gospel reading always containing the
words & teachings of Jesus from one of
the 4 gospels, always read by the priest*
- 5. homily of the priest*
- 6. the profession of faith in the Nicæan
creed written in 325 AD to show what
Christians believe*
- 7. prays for the people of the church*

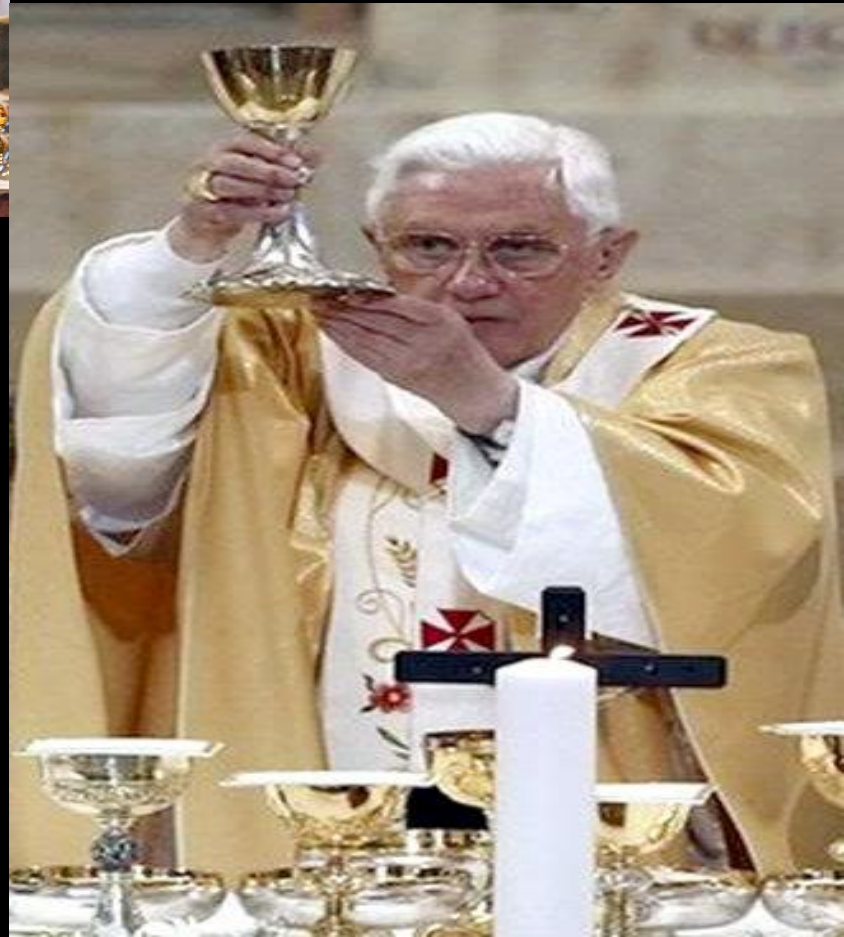

The Concluding Rite

1.the greeting & blessing

2.the dismissal with a joyful song

Receiving the Eucharist

1. all Catholics are obliged to attend mass on the Sabbath, once a week
2. all Catholics are obliged to receive communion once a year, during the Easter Season
3. only Catholics can receive holy communion
4. cannot receive communion if you are in the state of mortal sin

Benefits of Receiving Communion

1. Builds our relationship with Jesus.
2. Strengthens our relationship with the Church.
3. It unites all members together to be a vital force for the Lord.
4. It forgives all our venial sins and strengthens us to resist more serious sins.
5. The Holy Spirit strengthens us to send us forth to be Christ's presence in the world.
