

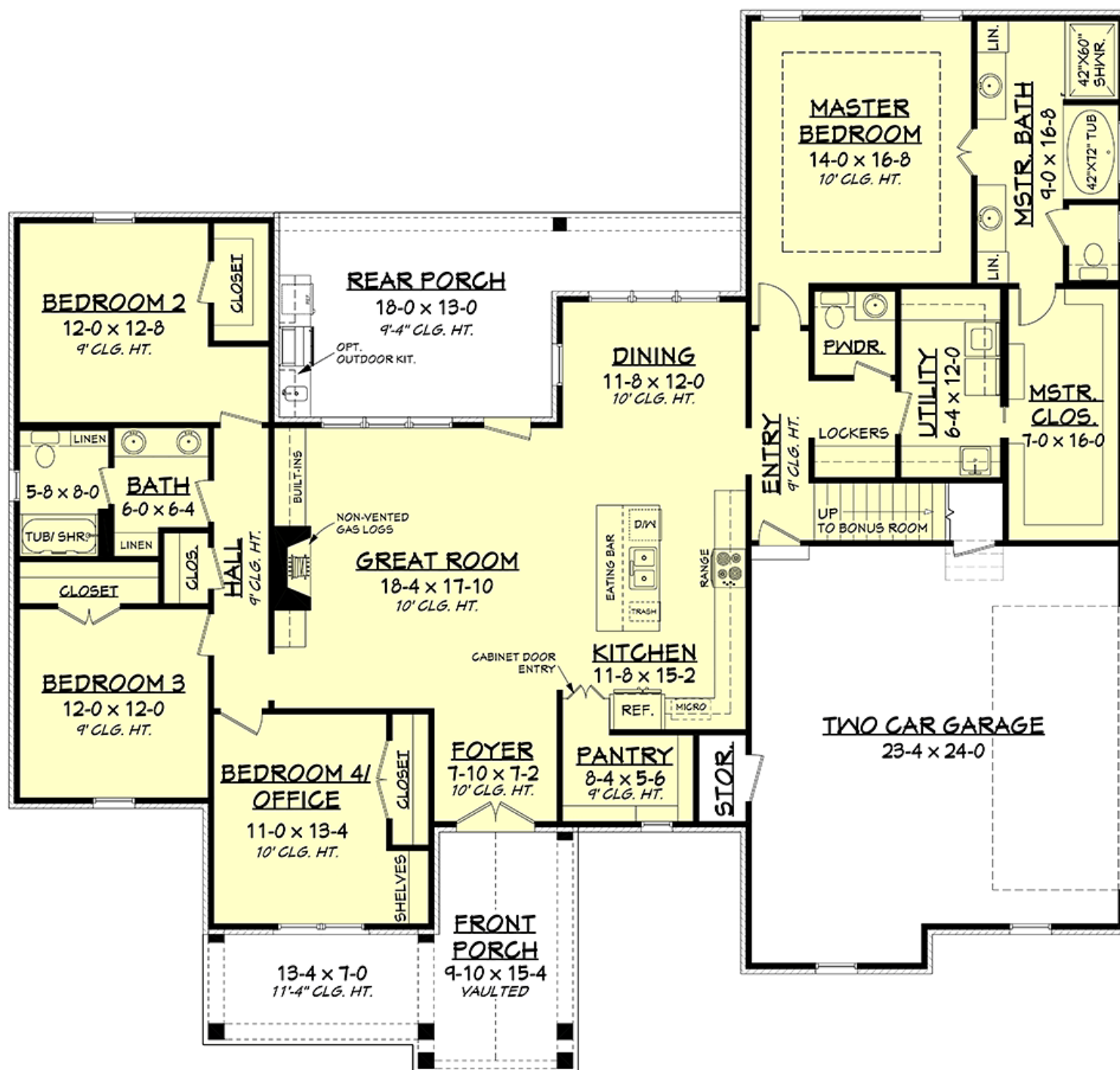
The Our Father

Amen.

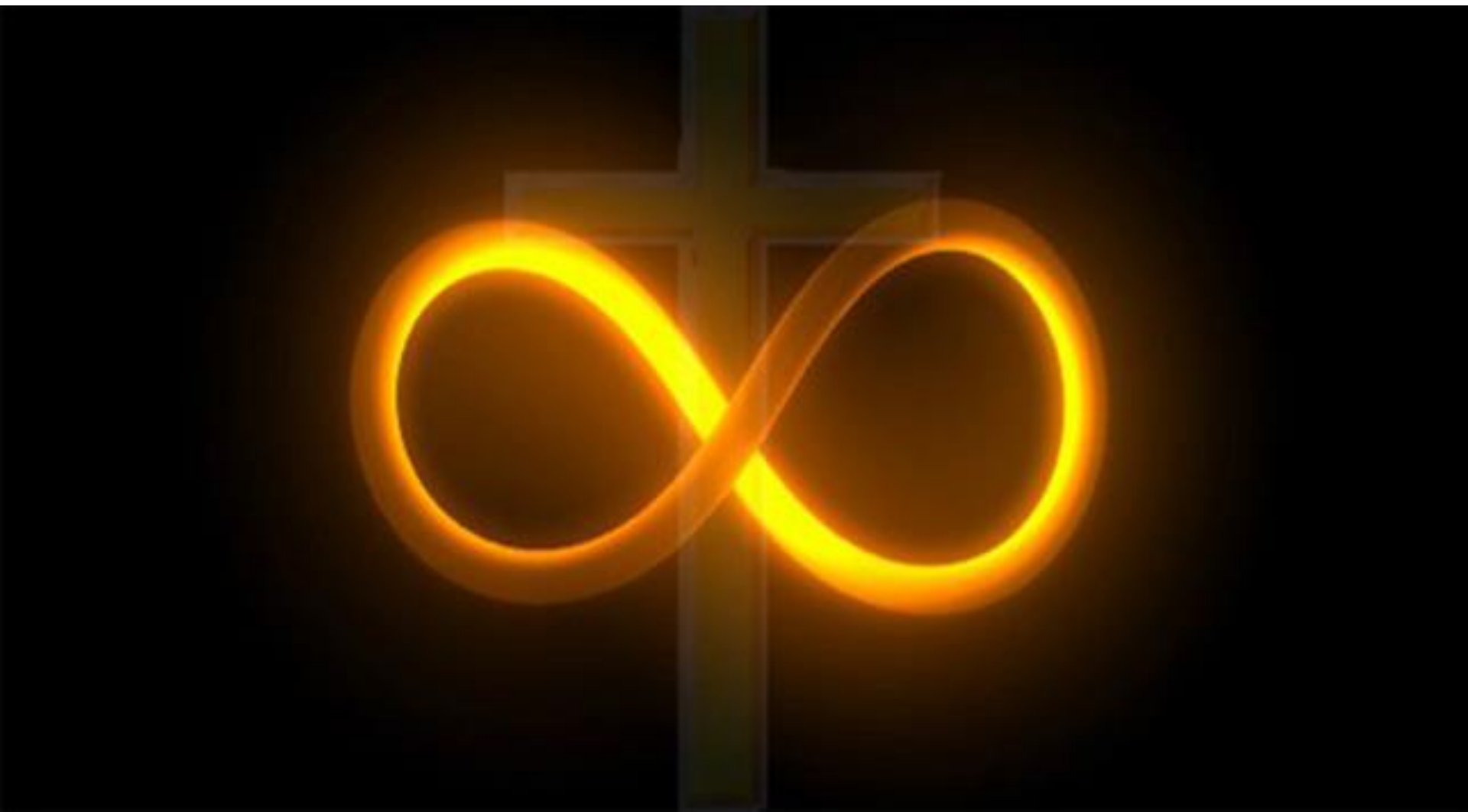






God our Father,

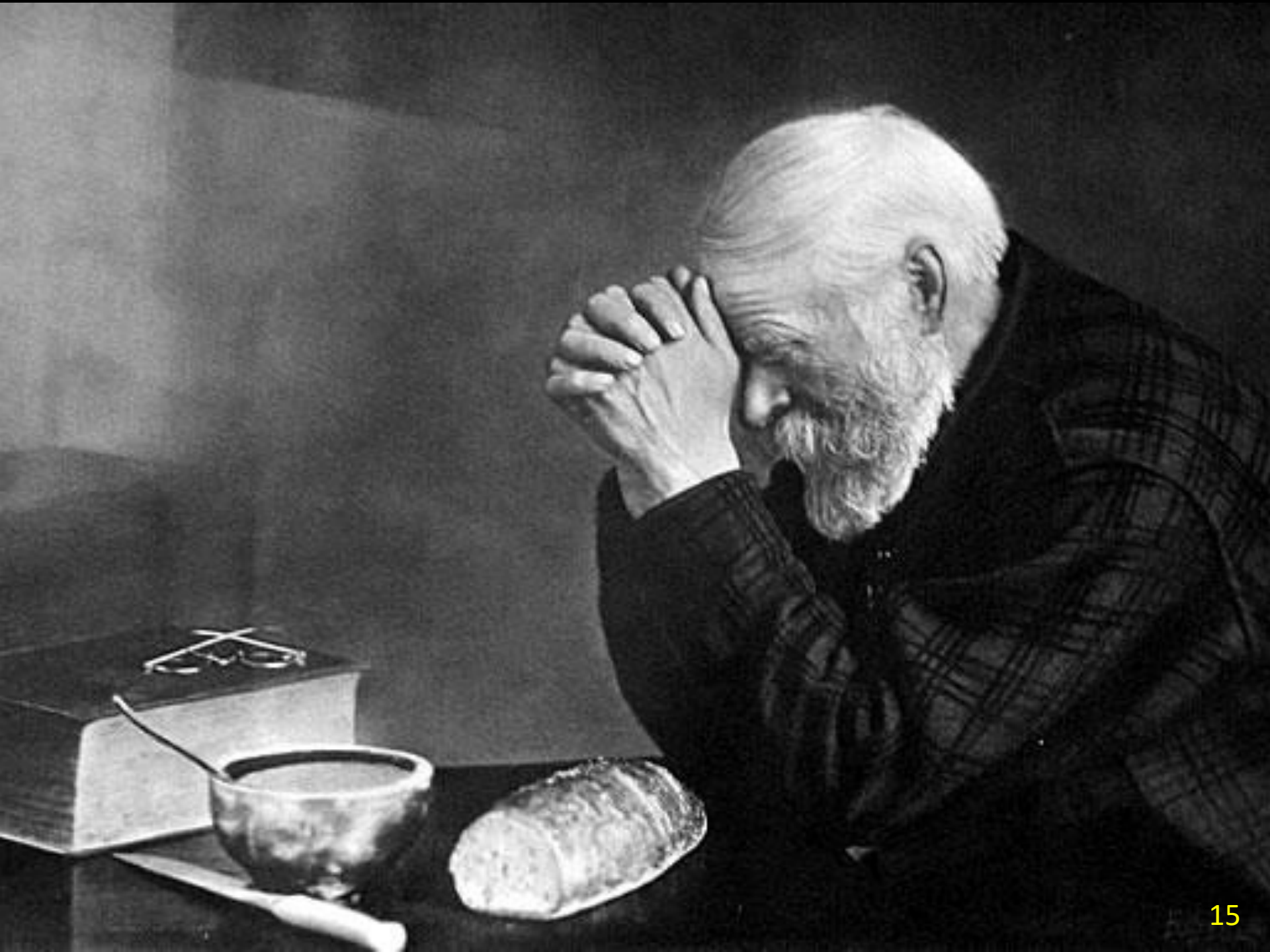
