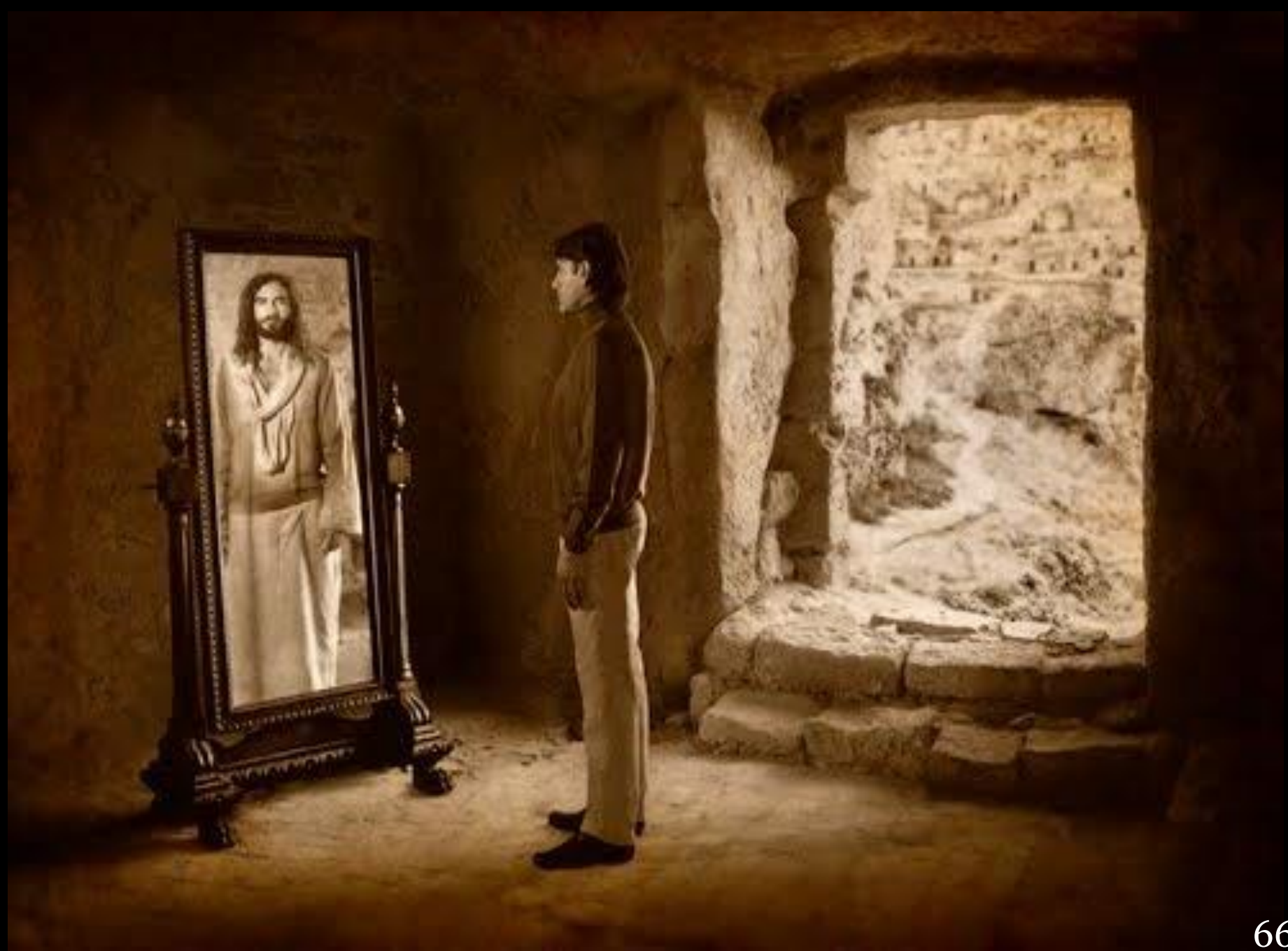






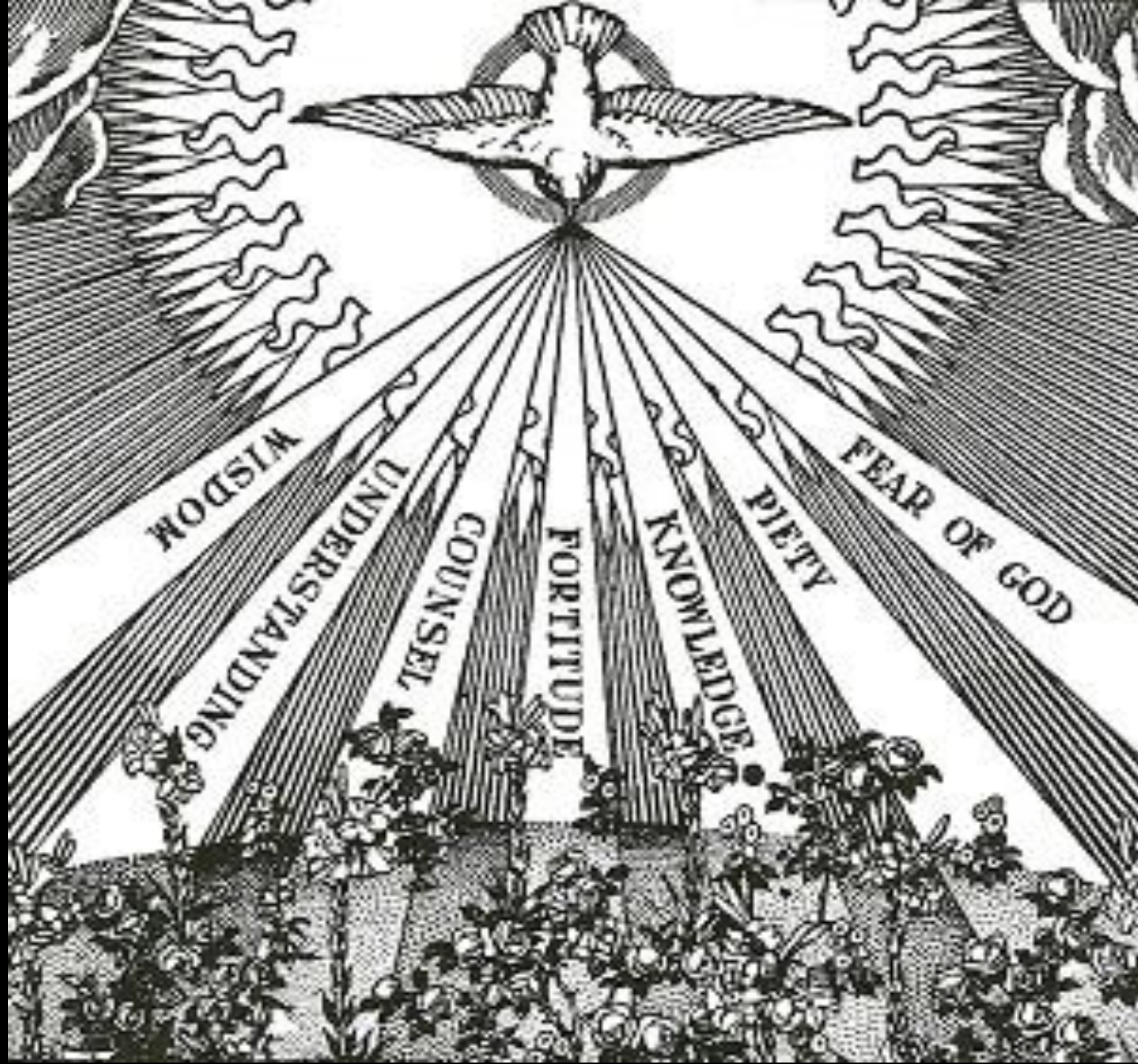
















Requirements for Confirmation
