(SOUND EFFECT) There once was a man named Daniel who was the right-hand man out of all to King Darius who had finally conquered the Kingdom of Babylon.

The other high officials in the court became jealous of Daniel and looked for flaws they could use against him.

High official 1: Daniel drives me mad! We need to find something he does wrong so we can get rid of him.

High official 2: But he never does anything wrong! Every night I go to sleep with the sound of his prayers and wake up to it.

High official 1: That's it! Keep praying Daniel... let's make a law requiring all to worship the King. Daniel will break the law because he will want to remain faithful to his God. (SOUND EFFECT)

High official 2: "O King Darius, live forever!

High Official 1: Your highness, we have a new law for you that will show everyone your power.

King Darius: Do tell.

High official 1: You are an amazing king, so you should make a rule requiring everyone to only worship you. If anyone doesn't, you should throw them into a lion's den as punishment. (SOUND EFFECT)

Narrator: Then the King signed the document and injunction. (SOUND EFFECT)

Narrator: Oh no! but what of Daniel?

Well, Daniel heard of the law, he still continued to worship and pray to his God three times a day in a room with all the windows open. [Daniel goes down on his knees to pray and worship] The High officials caught Daniel praying and report the incident to the king.

High official 2: King Darius, we caught someone breaking your law.

High official 1: But he would like to see you.

King Darius: Shocked expression.

Narrator: As soon as morning came, the king rushed to the den.

Daniel: O king, live forever! (Daniel told everything.) because I was found blameless before God; and also before you, O king, I have done no harm.

Narrator: The king was exceedingly glad, and commanded that Daniel be taken up out of the den. Daniel went up. The King examined and no kind of harm was found on him, no scratch, no blood, no fur, no torn clothes because he had trusted in his God. (SOUND EFFECT)

King Darius: Now, Find those that advised me to make that awful law and throw them into the pit!

Narrator: From then on King Darius wrote saying:
